### **Tomatoes – Small**

#### **Black Cherry - 2014**



Delicious, small, sweet tomato. Tastes like candy, only it is good for you!

#### **Fox Cherry - 2002**



Prototypical cherry tomato with full flavor. Great producer.

**Goldtreffen – 2003**



Plum sized gold tomato. Sweet and delicious.

**Tomatoes – Medium Sized Slicing**

**Black Krim – 2009**



Dark red variety with excellent flavor.

**Cosmonaut Volkov – 2007**



Best flavored red slicing tomato we have encountered.

**German Johnson – 2019**



Larger sized medium with dark pink flesh and excellent flavor.

### **Brandywine – 2004**



Large, pink heirloom tomato with legendary flavor.

### **Cherokee Purple – 2004**



Large, purple heirloom tomato rated amongst the best flavored.

**Pineapple – 2010**



Large yellow tomato with red splashing  
and excellent flavor.

**Pruden's Purple – 2017**



Very large pink tomato similar to  
Brandywine, but bigger.

Gourmet heirloom paste tomato. Leaves  
Romas in the dust, so to speak.

### **Purple de Milpa – 2002**



Best flavored tomatillo period. Main ingredient  
in salsa verde.

## **Peppers- Sweet**

### **Jupiter – 2020**



Large, thick walled, sweet red  
bell peppers.

### **Orange Bell – 2020**



Large, thick walled, sweet orange  
bell peppers.

## **Peppers – Chile**

### **Cayenne – 2020**



Prolific hot pepper. Great dried or made into hot sauce.

### **Poblano – 2020**



Mild hot pepper. Known for stuffing and roasting (Ancho).

### **Black Beauty**



Purple Italian eggplant.

### **Jalapeno – 2020**



The classic hot pepper. Goes great in everything.

Small hot pepper used often in salsas.

## **Flowers – Annuals**



**Pacific Beauty Calendula – annual heirloom. 12 – 24” tall. Prefers cool conditions.**



**Sensation Blend Cosmos – hardy annual. 3 – 4’ tall.**



**Dwarf Jewel Nasturtium – tender annual. 12-24” tall. Edible flowers.**



**Jasmine Scented Nicotiana – annual. 24”-36” tall. Blooms in evening.**



**Petunia – annual. Hanging basket flower.**



**Portulaca – annual. 6” tall. Drought resistant. Bears until frost.**



**Roggli Riesen Strawflower – annual. 30-36” tall. Great for drying.**



**Giant Purple Zinnia – annual. 40”-50” tall. Heat tolerant. 4”-6” blooms.**



**Red Scarlet Zinnia – annual. 30”-36” tall. Cold tolerant.**

### **Flowers – Biennial**



**Rose Campion – biennial. 32” tall. Cut flower. Self-sows.**

### **Flowers – Perennials**



**Volcano Mix Dianthus – tender perennial. 20”-24”. Cut flower. Edible petals.**



**Purple Echinacea – perennial. 24”-36” tall. Drought resistant. Medicinal.**



**Dynamic Scabiosa – tender perennial. 24”-36” tall. Cut flower. Pollinator attractor.**



**Lion's Mouth Snapdragon – perennial. 12"-24" tall. Cut flower.**



**Sweet William - perennial. 12"-18" tall. Sweet scented cut flower.**
